

Recommendations of Inter Ministerial Team

1. Remodeling and construction of Two Roomed Tenements at Jammu in place of the existing One Roomed Tenements involving an expenditure of Rs 127.00 Crores out of which an amount of Rs 117 Crores is to be provided as Additional Central Assistance.
2. Construction and remodeling of tenements at Udhampur and Kathua involving an expenditure of Rs 10.00 Crores to be provided as Additional Central Assistance.
3. Creation of Empowered Committee headed by the State Chief Secretary for administration of a corpus of Rs 5.00 Crores to be established for catering to miscellaneous development needs of the Migrants ,viz. health, education, vocational skill building, library facilities, sports facilities etc. Rs 4.50 Crores to be provided as Additional Central Assistance and Rs 0.50 Crores to be met by the State Government.
4. The construction of 200 two roomed flats at Shiekhpora District Budgam at an expenditure of Rs 20.00 Crores to be provided under Security Related Expenditure of the Ministry of Home Affairs.
5. Rs1.00 Crores out of ACA for the improvement /Provision of infrastructure in the Kashmir Valley for facilitating the return of the Migrants.
6. Compensation for the houses damaged due to natural calamities as per the norms of the Calamity Relief Fund for Rs 1.40 Crores.
7. Rs 0.35 Crores out of ACA for the provision of medical equipment and sports facilities for camps.
8. A verification of relief cases receiving cash doles to weed out ineligible recipients.
9. Preparation of health profiles of the Camp Migrants and provision of specialized health care out of the corpus fund.
10. Creation of 1000 Jobs opportunities for the Migrants.
11. Establishment of Self Help Women's Groups.
12. Entrepreneurial Development Programmes and setting up of 1000 cottage/small scale industries.
13. Provision of soft loan to the Migrants.
14. Up gradation of Migrant schools as resource centres at an expenditure of Rs 0.20 Crores to be provided as Additional Central Assistance.
15. Special Educational Dispensations for the Migrant students in more States for admission in Engineering/Medical Colleges.
16. Payment of HRA and CCA to Migrant Government employees at an estimated expenditure of Rs 6 Crores.
17. Restoration and repair of Temples/Holy Shrines in the Valley under the supervision of Empowered Committee headed by the State Chief Secretary.
18. Preparation of a blue print for the promotion of the Kashmiri Language and literature of the State Cultural Academy.
